Privacy Policy

VISION III IMAGING, INC. Online Privacy Policy

VISION III IMAGING, INC. has prepared this Privacy Policy to describe the types of personal and non-personal information collected through its Web site ("Website"), the use of such information, and to whom and under what circumstances the such information is disclosed. By using this Website, you signify your assent to this Privacy Policy and to the Website's Terms of Use . If you do not agree to the terms of this Privacy Policy or the Website's Terms of Use , please do not use the Website.

Collection of Information • Personal Information

In general, VISION III IMAGING, INC. only collects personal information from you when you voluntarily provide it to us by (1) registering on the Website; (2) participating in one of the discussion forums; (3) subscribing to one of the services, such as news, media, and magazine services; (4) ordering products from the Online Product Catalog; (5) making product or service inquiries; and (6) contacting VISION III IMAGING, INC. (including the webmaster, customer service representatives, or other employees) by email. In connection with these activities, VISION III IMAGING, INC. may collect personal information from you, including, but not limited to, your name, physical address, e-mail address, username, password, a picture of you, certain preference information (such as favorite URLs), whether or not you are a VISION III IMAGING, INC. member, purchase information from the Online Product Catalog, telephone number, fax number, company name, title, tax jurisdiction, credit card number, and credit card expiration date.

Non-personal information

As part of the standard operation of the Website, VISION III IMAGING, INC. may collect certain non-personal information from you including, but not limited to, your browser type (e.g., Netscape or Internet Explorer), operating system (e.g., Windows or Macintosh), Internet service provider, IP address, and the domain name from which you accessed the Website (e.g., yahoo.org).

In addition, VISION III IMAGING, INC. may collect information about your browsing behavior, such as the date and time you visit the Website, the areas or pages of the Website that you visit, the amount of time spent viewing the Website, the number of times you return to the Website, and other click-stream data. VISION III IMAGING, INC. may use cookies to collect this information, which may be combined with your personal information. A cookie is a small text file that may be stored on the hard drive of your computer when you access the Website and which enables us to recognize your computer when you return to the Website. Cookies also allow us to remember your username and password so that you do not have to re-enter this information each time you login to the Website.

You are always free to decline cookies, but in doing so you may not be able to use certain features on the Website. The "help" segment of the toolbar on most browsers explains how to

configure a browser to not accept new cookies, how to have the browser inform a user when they receive a new cookie, and how to erase cookies from their hard drives.

Use of Information

VISION III IMAGING, INC. may use the information collected from you for any of the following purposes: (1) to facilitate your use of the Website and better understand your needs; (2) to process and fulfill your orders for certain products and services; (3) to respond to your inquiries or requests for information about the products and services; (4) to send you information, promotional materials, and offers from VISION III IMAGING, INC. as well as from its subsidiaries and affiliates; (5) to contact visitors to the Website when necessary; (6) to help address problems with the Website; (7) to administer the Website; (8) to conduct internal reviews of the Website (e.g., to determine the number of visitors to specific pages within the site); (9) to help us better understand visitors' use of the Website; and (10) to protect the security or integrity of the Website.

Non-personal information will be used for these purposes as well to monitor the Website and provide a greater online experience for the visitors.

Disclosure of Information

VISION III IMAGING, INC. may transfer or otherwise disclose information collected from you to the following entities for the following purposes: (1) to VISION III IMAGING, INC.'s employees, independent contractors, subsidiaries, affiliates, consultants, business associates, service providers, and suppliers, if the disclosure will enable that entity to perform a business, professional, or technical support function for VISION III IMAGING, INC.; (2) to employees, independent contractors, service providers, and suppliers of VISION III IMAGING, INC. to fulfill a product or service request; (3) as necessary if VISION III IMAGING, INC. determines that there has been a violation of the VISION III IMAGING, INC. Terms of Use; and (4) to respond to judicial process and provide information to law enforcement agencies or in connection with an investigation on matters related to public safety, as permitted by law.

Children

VISION III IMAGING, INC. does not direct the Website to, nor does it knowingly collect any personal information from, children under 13.
